5.	avoid	sakınmak	The suspect avoided <b>talking</b> to the police.
6.	can't help	knd.ni yapmaktan alıkoyamamak	I can't help <b>thinking</b> about the past.
7.	can't stand*	katlanamamak(can't bear)	Lily can't stand <b>working</b> in a smoky atmosphere.

15.	discuss	fikir alışverişi yapmak	We've discussed <b>opening</b> a new business.
16.	dislike*	hoşlanmamak	He dislikes <b>being</b> the focus of attention.
